Online Poster-Making Competition

Theme: *Stay Safe Online: Women's Safety in the Digital World*

The National Commission for Women (NCW), Ministry of Women and Child Development, in collaboration with **MyGov**, invites undergraduate and postgraduate students across India to participate in an **Online Poster-Making Competition** aimed at promoting awareness on women's safety in the digital space.

The competition provides a creative platform for students to visually communicate the importance of **digital safety, respect, resilience, and protection of women's online identities**. Participants are encouraged to design impactful posters that promote responsible online behaviour, digital literacy, and empowerment, aligned with NCW's vision of creating a safer digital environment for women.

Eligibility

- Open to **UG and PG students** enrolled in recognized colleges/universities in India
- Open to participants of **all genders and academic disciplines**
- **One entry per participant** (individual entries only)

Technical Specifications

- **Hand-drawn posters** on A3 or A4 size (portrait or landscape)
- File format: **JPEG/JPG/PDF** (Max size: **4 MB**)
- Scanned copy or high-quality photograph

Submission Guidelines

- Language: **English or Hindi** (with a short caption)
- Include a **brief description (max 100 words)** explaining the poster concept
- Artwork must be **original and unpublished**
- No mention of author's name or contact details on the poster
- Upload entries **only** <https://share.google/GPwpAEyuAQfyGiUMJ>
- Ensure MyGov profile details are complete and accurate

Disqualification

Entries will be rejected if they contain offensive/obscene content, violate originality norms, fail to meet technical requirements, or involve multiple submissions by the same participant.

Prizes

- **1st Prize:** ₹21,000
- **2nd Prize:** ₹15,000
- **3rd Prize:** ₹10,000
- **All participants** will receive an **e-Certificate of Appreciation** from NCW
